Specific History

General History

The Silver Cloud was the zenith of prestige and luxury, carry on the Rolls – Royce name from 1955 –1965. Despite being new in 1955 the Silver Cloud was fitted with proven mechanicals. The elegant coach work designed by John Blatchley covered a 4.9 litre straight six-cylinder engine used in the pre war II Silver Wraith as well as a live rear axle and four-wheel drum brakes.
